

Ann M. Schindel Chair for Teachers of Mathematics



Dr. Ann Marjorie Schindel (1947-1983) was a 1964 graduate of Athens High School. She was an exceptional student, with accomplishments in a wide range of fields from music to zoology. She graduated from the University of Georgia with a master's degree in mathematics and from the Medical College of Georgia, and was on the medical staff of North Carolina Memorial Hospital in Chapel Hill, NC, at the time of her death. Dr. Schindel's life and work serve as an inspiration.

The *Ann M. Schindel Chair for Teachers of Mathematics* was established in 1996 by her parents, Robert and Reba Schindel, and was first awarded in 1997. The Chair is currently given in odd-numbered years, for a two-year term.
