Cardee Kilpatrick Chair for Middle School Teachers



Carleen (Cardee) Kilpatrick was the first Executive Director of the Foundation for Excellence from 1984 to 1989. She also served as a member of the Clarke County Board of Education, the Athens-Clarke County Commission from 1991-2004, and as a member of the Athens City Council from 1987-1990, with stints as Mayor Pro Tem. Ms. Kilpatrick also served on the Industrial Development and Economic Development Authorities, was a member of the charter Leadership Athens class in 1982, and has served on a number of community boards including the Convention and Visitor's Bureau, Piedmont College, Classic Center Cultural Foundation, and Athens Community Council on Aging. She has received numerous awards, including the Athens Area Chamber of Commerce Bentley Award.

The *Cardee Kilpatrick Chair for Middle School Teachers* was established in 1990. The Chair is currently given in odd-numbered years, for a two-year term.
