

Todd Cooper Memorial Grant for Technology and Equipment



Todd Fielding Cooper (1982-1998) was the youngest in a family of three boys, much loved by his parents and brothers. He attended Whitehead Road ES, Clarke MS, and Clarke Central HS. He dreamed of being a fighter pilot like his grandfather, who flew off the USS Yorktown during World War II. He loved computers and video games, his large, boisterous extended family in New Jersey, and his circle of friends at Clarke Central. His suicide at the age of sixteen changed the lives of all who knew and loved him, often for the better, a gift from him beyond death, as is the grant given in his memory.
